District Wide Safety/Security Items**

Increase Lockdown Ability

Increasing the lockdown ability of our schools in emergency situations. Add interior classroom door locks, increase electronic lockdown capabilities of buildings by upgrading existing fire doors and exterior doors as needed/possible.

Improve Campus Access Control

Improving campus access control. Increase our schools' ability to control who enters and exits our campuses. Possible solutions could range from addition of lighting, fencing, signage, visibility from offices, etc. Campus access control will be further refined and detailed as our safety consultants, *Corporate Security Services*, identify and give recommendations on how to best provide the necessary access and yet control it on our campuses.

Upgrade District-wide Telephone/Voicemail System

The current system has reached "end of life" and no longer supported by the manufacturer. As phone system is upgraded the district computer network will also be upgraded.

Upgrade/Replacement of Public Address Systems

Installing/improving school public address systems. PA system coverage to include playgrounds, bus areas, playfields, etc. Provide quick effective communication to our campuses in times of emergency.

Additional Emergency Generators

Ferndale High School: Houses the district's main computer and phone systems. Continuous power is necessary to maintain district data and communication systems.

FSD District Office: In times of emergency, the district office will serve as the Emergency Operations Center: the communication hub and logistical center for district emergency operations.

Beach Elementary School: A generator is needed at Beach Elementary due to the remote nature of the school and for community use during emergencies.
