CURRICULUM ADOPTION

The board is responsible for assuring that a quality program is offered which reflects state standards and is consistent with the expectations of the parents and students of the district.

Courses of study and/or program offerings must reflect the needs of students. As needs change, program offerings must respond. At the beginning of each school year, the superintendent shall advise the board of any program changes, additions or deletions that are planned for the year.

All courses of study, including but not limited to, health, physical education, industrial arts, business, vocational-technical and home economics, shall be accessible to students regardless of gender. Exceptions may include human sexuality classes or portions thereof.
