

Ferndale Education Association Scholarship Application

The Ferndale Education Association provides two \$1000 scholarships to eligible Ferndale High School seniors who will continue their education during the fall immediately following high school graduation. The recipients must enroll at an educational institution that offers programs leading to a bachelor's degree. The scholarship funds are to be applied towards tuition, fees and books. The intent of these scholarships is to encourage Ferndale High School graduates to enter the field of education and become certified teachers.

Application Guidelines:

1. Applicant must be a Ferndale High School senior.
2. Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA
3. A copy of applicant's high school transcript must be provided.
4. Only two personal references will be accepted. One reference should be someone familiar with your academic ability (teacher, counselor, principal); the other reference may be an employer, minister, adult family friend, etc.
5. Preference in selection will be given to applicants who plan to enter the field of education.
6. Applicants should be prepared for the possibility of an interview.
