

**FERNDALE HIGH SCHOOL
FINE AND PERFORMING ARTS SCHOLARSHIP**

APPLICATION DEADLINE: April 1, 2009

The Ferndale Theatre Arts Department provides scholarships to eligible Ferndale High School seniors who will continue their education following graduation from high school. The recipients must enroll at an educational institution which offers programs that lead to a bachelor's degree, associate's degree, or a fine and performing arts degree.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES:

1. Applicant must be a Ferndale High School senior who has participated in drama activities during his/her high school career. Such activities could include, but are not limited to, acting, participating in the pit orchestra, working as an artist, gathering props, building sets, running/designing lights, sound etc.
2. Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

THIS APPLICATION MUST INCLUDE:

1. A copy of the applicant's high school transcript.
2. Two letters of recommendation.

Along with the 2 letters of recommendation and transcript, please answer the following questions:

1. List all school related organizations that you have belonged to and activities you have participated in (do not include sports in your answer to this question). Please also include the length of time you participated in each activity and if offices were held.
2. List all sports activities you have participated in, as well as the number of years involved.
3. List any community and church activities you have been involved in.
4. List any honors that you have received during your high school career.
5. Explain your plans for further education.
6. Explain how the fine and performing arts are significant in your life and how it is relevant throughout the world. Please also include how you have been involved in theatre, what you have learned from those experiences, and how those experiences might help you in the future.
