Immunizations required for incoming Sixth Graders

Washington State Law requires that all sixth graders have at least one Varicella (Chicken Pox) Vaccine.

Washington State Law also requires that children who are 11 years old by the start of sixth grade and have not received a Dtap, DT or Td vaccine in the last 5 years, are due for a Tdap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis) Vaccination.

If your student has already receive these vaccines, (and are over age 11 for the Tdap) please let the school office know the dates of your student immunizations. If your student has not had these vaccines, please make an appointment with your doctor and let the school office know the dates of the immunization after your child's appointment.

Any student who is not fully immunized by the first day of school will not be placed on a class list.
