Ferndale Family and Student Access gives you up-to-date information on your student's **grades and assignments, attendance, student schedules and more**. Follow the directions below to get yourself logged in.

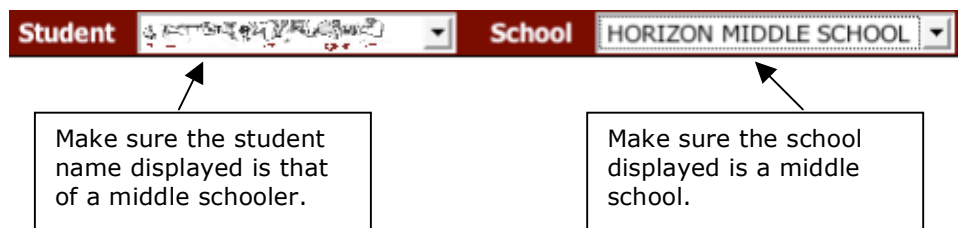
Step 1: Get logged in

Parents and students log in at the same site. To get there, take your web browser to the login page at <http://family.ferndale.wa-k12.net>. It would be a good idea to bookmark this page for quick reference in the future.

Enter your login (an alpha-numeric key like SMITHJOH001) and password and click "Login."

Step 2: Choose the correct student and school (Parents only)

Students will be taken directly to their record. If parents have more than one student in the district, they will need to choose which student's record to view. Use the Student and School drop-down boxes at the top of the screen to choose your student. Currently, only middle schoolers have information available for them in the system.



Step 3: Navigate the options

If you've done everything correctly, a Student Information page should display, along with a navigation bar on the side of your screen that looks like this
